Double-check your store's phone number, website, and opening hours.

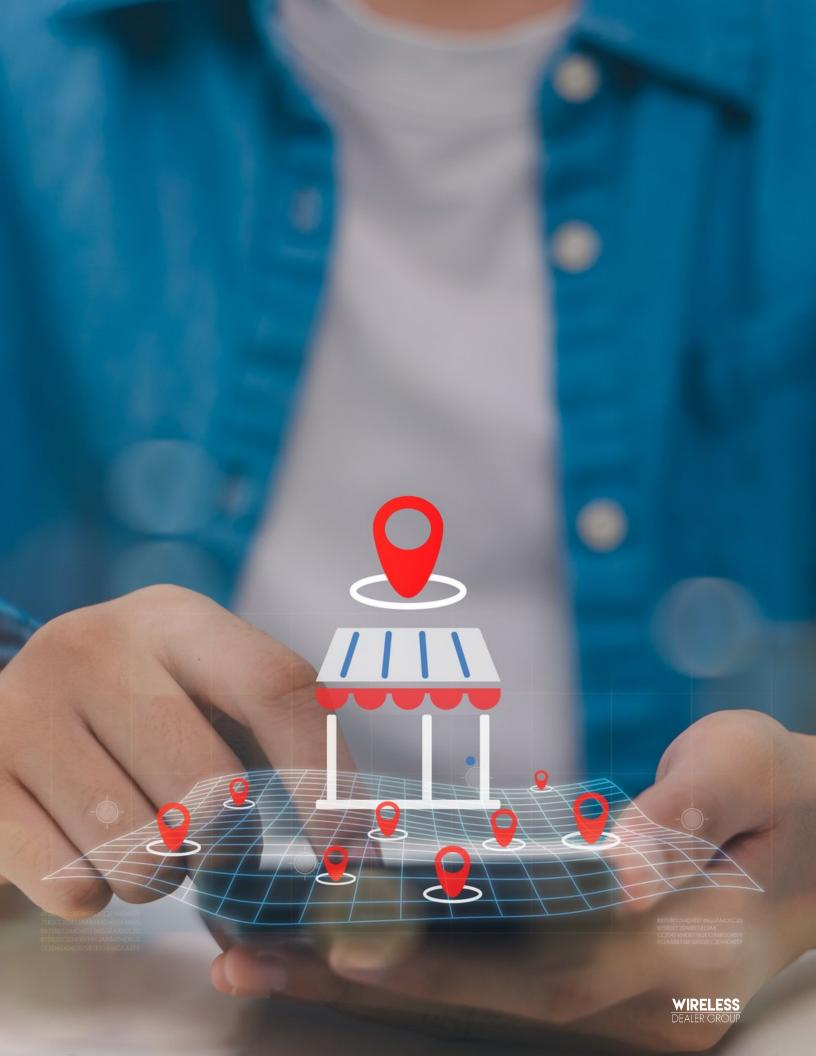

Verifying Your Business



Verification tells Google—and your customers—that your listing is authentic. Most often, Google sends a postcard to your store with a unique code. Here's what to expect:

How to Verify Your Listing:

- 1. After your listing is entered, Google will present available verification options.
- 2. The most common is a **postcard by mail** to your business address. Enter the code on your Google Business dashboard once you receive it.
- 3. Occasionally, you may be offered **phone** or **email** verification.
- 4. Complete the process promptly to activate your listing.

Tips:

- Do not make major changes to your store name, address, or category during the verification period—this can delay or reset the process.
- Keep an eye on your mail; postcards generally arrive within 5 days.

Once verified, your cellphone store becomes discoverable across Google Search and Maps!



Keep It Fresh

Adding & Updating Store Information for Success



Once your business is verified, maintaining up-to-date information is key to ongoing success on Google Business. The more accurate and complete your profile, the more customers trust you and the easier it is for them to visit, call, or purchase.

Essential Information to Add & Update

- Store Hours: Keep these current, especially during holidays or special events.
- Website Link: Make sure it points to the correct page—ideally your homepage or appointment booking section.
- Category & Services: Update as your business evolves. Offer repairs? Add that service!
- Products and Specials: You can list phones, accessories, or repair services to showcase inventory.
- Accessibility Info: Parking, wheelchair access, etc.
- COVID-19 Updates: Use attributes to communicate masks, cleaning protocols, curbside service, or appointment requirements.

Why Updates Matter

Customers may get frustrated if they arrive at your store only to find it closed. Google gives higher ranking to stores with complete and current info.

Update Regularly:

- Check your listing once a week.
- Immediately update if anything changes—especially phone number, hours, or website.

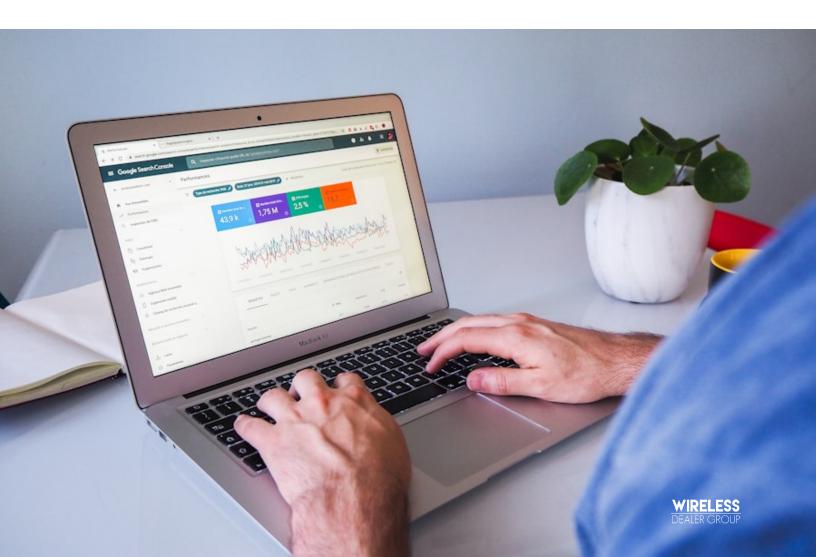

Troubleshooting

Solving Common Google Business Listing Issues

Even the best-managed Google Business listings can run into challenges. Knowing how to solve them quickly keeps your store's digital presence—and reputation—intact.



Problem 1: Listing Not Showing Up in Search

Possible Causes:

- Unverified listing
- Incomplete information
- Category mismatch

- Complete verification.
- Double-check all fields, especially business name, category, and address.
- Update your description and keep photos fresh.



Problem 2: Incorrect Information Displayed

Possible Causes:

- Info changed by Google or "suggested edits" by users.
- Old or conflicting details from other online directories.

- Correct information in your Google Business dashboard.
- Make sure other online listings (Yelp, YellowPages, etc.) match exactly.
- Check regularly for edits that need approval.



Problem 3: Fake or Inappropriate Reviews

- Flag reviews that violate Google's content policies in your dashboard.
- For legitimate criticism, reply professionally.
- Encourage more real, positive reviews to outweigh the occasional negative.



Problem 4: Duplicate Listings

- Search for duplicate listings.
- Claim and merge or request removal of duplicates via Google Business support.



Problem 5: Verification Delays

- If your code postcard hasn't arrived, request a new one after 14 days.
- Ensure your address is clearly visible and matches that on your signage and online.

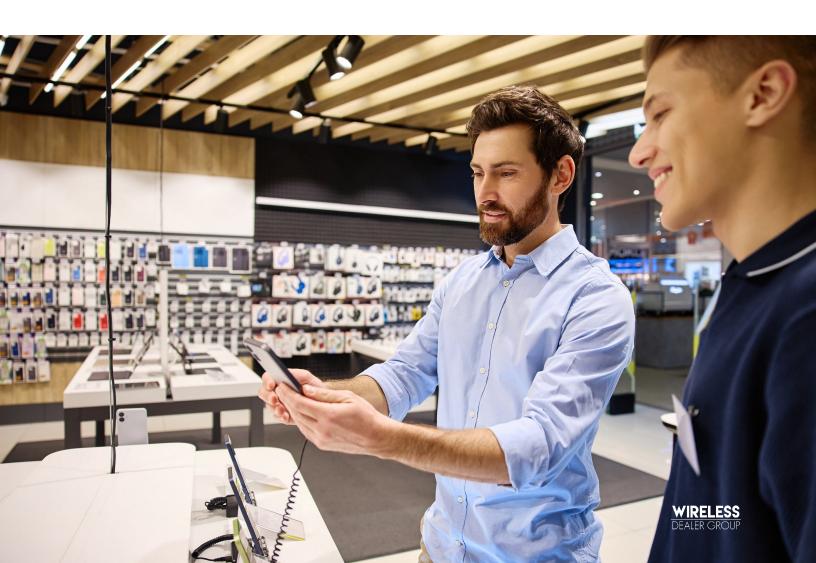
